To qualify for the SILS International Scholarship you must be a **full-time student** (undergraduate or graduate) seeking a degree from the University of North Carolina at Chapel Hill's School of Information and Library Science. The scholarship awards 6 qualifying students a one-time payment of \$1,000. This amount is applied directly to the cost of program registration. Students are then responsible for paying the balance of their registration cost.

Recipients are required to:

- 1.) Take the seminar for credit and attend classes held during the seminar.
- 2.) Remain enrolled at SILS for the fall 2019 semester.
- 3.) Complete a Follow-On Project: In fall 2019 you will be required to complete a project that helps promote study abroad at SILS. The extent of the project is entirely up to you and is a component of your application.
