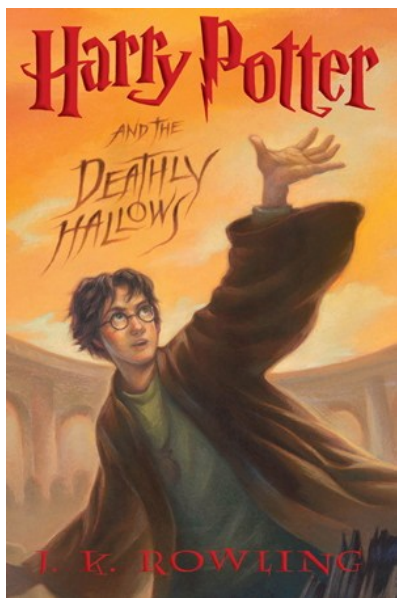

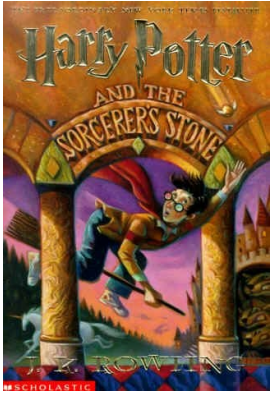

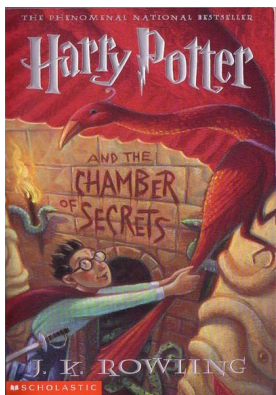
Harry Potter and the Sorcerer's Stone

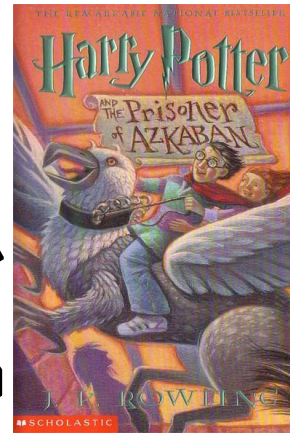
Harry Potter and the Chamber of Secrets

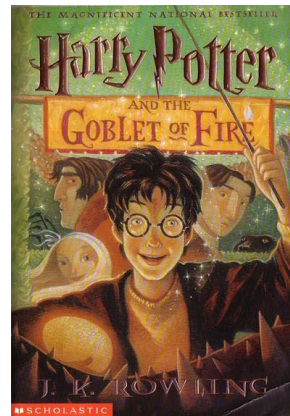

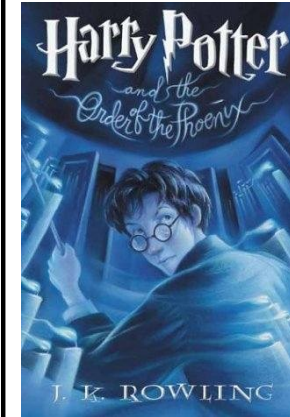

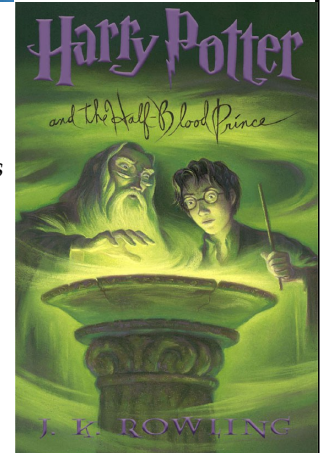
