The illustrator award was first awarded in 1974. The author award began four years earlier in 1970.

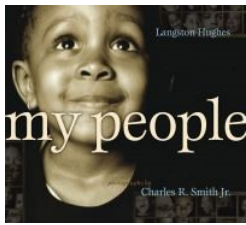
# Coretta Scott King Book Award: Illustrator
